

## National Health Service Corps Scholarship Prog 10<sup>12</sup>

Program Description	Students pursuing a career in primary health care are eligible to receive funding for their education in exchange for practicing in rural, urban, and tribal communities with limited access to care, upon graduation and licensure.
Eligible Disciplines	<ul> <li>Enrolled or accepted in the following primary health care disciplines in an eligible degree program in a U.S. state or territory:</li> <li>Primary Care Physician (MD or DO)</li> <li>Dentist (DDS or DMD)</li> <li>Nurse Practitioner (NP)</li> <li>Certified Nurse-Midwife (CNM)</li> <li>Physician Assistant (PA)</li> </ul>
Service Commitment	1-year service commitment per scholarship year or partial scholarship year; 2-year minimum and 4-year maximum.
Financial Benefits	<ul><li>Funding for a maximum of 4 years:</li><li>Tuition</li><li>Required fees</li></ul>
