A101 Guide to Applying for Scholarships to Study Abroad

Most Scholarships will require an essay of some sort—write what you know. You are passionate about creating theater and sharing that with people. Use your passion to help craft a strong essay.

Let people read it. Get feedback; write several drafts. U tilize the Writing Center at Pace.

Look for scholarships that want to support *you* for *you*. There are many scholarships and awards out there supporting excellence in minority groups, LGBTQIA students, children of veterans etc.

Cast a wide net by applying to multiple funding sources. Don't put all your eggs in one basket.

Look beyond scholarships for students. There's a lot of money out there for **young artists** too.

THIS IS HARDWORK! Some students make greate orts when applying for grant money, whereas others do not submit a single scholarship application. Remember that people *want* to give you this money. Thousands of dollars a year don't get awarded because people don't apply for it, BUT you must fill out the applications to the best of your ability if you want to be eligible!
