Everyone currently on the waitlist for additional guest tickets will hear back from the Commencement Team via email by Wednesday, May 15.

Graduates should plan to arrive at least one hour before their scheduled ceremony start time. Graduates and guests with accessibility needs should plan to arrive 1.5–2 hours prior to their ceremony start time.

Your Grad Pass and guest tickets include the timing of your ceremonies. You can also [view the schedule of events](#) on the Commencement website.

On arrival, all graduates and guests will enter through the East Gate Main Entrance. Print or screenshot your Grad Pass and guest tickets in advance to avoid entry delays.

Graduates must present their Grad Passes at Graduate Check-in in the East Plaza, after entering at the East Gate Main Entrance.

Guests must present their tickets at the East Gate Main Entrance. After entering the venue, guests may proceed to the appropriate stadium for their graduate's ceremony.

Anyone without a Grad Pass or guest ticket will be prohibited from entering the venue.

Please you must wear academic regalia to participate in the Commencement ceremonies. Academic regalia includes a gown, cap, and a hood.

Bottle re-filling stations are available throughout the USTA complex. Bring your refillable bottles to stay hydrated!

The USTA's Grounds and Food Village will be open from 11:00 a.m.–4:00 p.m.; cash is not accepted.

We understand that there might be concerns about possible protests or disruptions on Commencement day, but be assured, we are closely monitoring the situation. Pace's dedicated Safety and Security team has been in regular communication with staff at the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center, who have their own professional team of safety officers. Together we are working to ensure that everyone—graduates and guests alike—will be supported when they celebrate this special day.
