The decision of the Appeals Committee equires a majority vote and is final and not subject to further review. The student will be notified of the decision of the Appeals Committee in writing assoon a practicable usually within fifteen (15) business days following the date on which the Appeals Committee made its decision.

Reinstatement After An Appeal. A student whosappeals granted willbe reinstated the appropriate ISC trackand the College of Health Profession as the casemaybe, on academic probation accordance with the applicable conditions of probation set for the Academic Probation Policy. A student who is reinstated and satisfies the conditions of probation within the time permitted can re-take the courses they failed.
